

Summer Daze Frequently Asked Questions

Who puts on Warrenville Summer Daze?

Warrenville Summer Daze is an event put on by the Warrenville Park District, City of Warrenville and the Western DuPage Chamber of Commerce.

Will there be an ATM onsite?

Are there any free kid's activities?

Yes! Friday, August 2 - Face Painting (5-7P); Magic Show (6-7:30P)

Saturday, August 3 - Miss Liz Children's Entertainer (2-3PM); Face Painting (2-4PM); Water Balloon Fight (6P); Hula Hoop Contest (6:30P); Sack Races (7P)

What are the kid's activities that are paid for?

Friday, August 2 - Inflatables (5-9P); Movie on the large inflatable screen in the WCB - Madagascar (8P) and Wonder Park (8P)

Saturday, August 4 - Inflatables (1-4P and 4:30-9P); Movie on the large inflatable screen in the WCB - Madagascar (6P) and Wonder Park (8P)

The inflatables and movies require a wristband. \$10 wristband per day unlimited or \$15 for Friday/Saturday combo.

Can I register for the Car Show on Saturday?

Yes, day of registration begins at 8A.

What time is the Car Show?

Saturday, August 3 from 10A-4P, or when judging is complete.

Can I bring my own beverages?

We do not allow any outside food or beverages. We will have food, water, soda, beer and wine for sale.

What types of beer and wine will be available?

Miller Lite, MGD, Leinenkugel's Summer Shandy, Coors Light, Angry Orchard, Mike's Hard Lemonade, Truly Lemonade, Truly Colima Lime, Truly Wild Rose; Revolution Brewing: Sun Crusher, Anti-Hero; Two Brothers: Prairie Path, Wobble, Pinball, and Domaine DuPage; and Wine: Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, and Prosecco.

What are the beer and wine token prices?

Beer and wine tokens are 1 for \$5 or 5 for \$20.

Can I bring my dog?

No dogs are allowed.

Where can I park?

Off-street parking is available near the City Hall complex, the Warrenville Park District and surrounding areas.

Is there handicapped parking available?

Handicapped parking is available on Rockwell near the library. During the car show, handicapped parking is available on Tracy Place next to the Police Station. After the Car Show, handicapped parking will be available along Warren Avenue across from the Community Building.
